2015 WORKSHOP INFORMATION & INSTRUCTORS



FIDDLE

TREVOR STUART

Trevor will teach old time fiddle tunes in various keys and tunings (multi level; NOT for the total beginner). "We will learn these tunes by breaking them down into sections, working on the bowing and timing that make them unique." The class will be taught by ear. Recording devices are highly recommended so you won't forget what you learn.

KELSEY WELLS

Kelsey will teach a variety of tunes in different keys and tunings. Classes will center around in-depth discussions of strong bowing rhythms and other ways to make tunes drive. All tunes will be taught by ear; please bring a recorder!

Saturday breakfast jam: Wake up to your favorite tunes in this inthe-round style jam. We'll play all the best-loved standards to get your fingers and brain ready for the day!

CLAWHAMMER BANJO

TRAVIS STUART

Travis' class will explore different old time banjo styles of the southern Appalachians. Focus will be on oldtime 2 & 3 fingers styles reminiscient of Doc Boggs and Obray Ramsey. (multi level; NOT for the total beginner). "We will use standard and other tunings and cover some solo tunes; playing along a fiddle; and some subtle right- and left-hand techniques to get an old time sound." The class will be taught by ear. Recording devices are highly recommended. Expect a lot of fun and bring your banjo.

ALAN O'BRYANT

Alan will teach a special class "old time" tunes for those who play the "5-string bluegrass banjo."

OLD TIME RHYTHM GUITAR

TIM MAY

(multi level; NOT for the total beginner) "We'll have fun learning about bass runs, chromatic walks, quarter-note and eighth-note runs and counter melodies" Tim will show examples from early 20th century old-time players.

MANDOLIN

TREVOR STUART

Trevor will teach old time tunes and the rhthym that goes along with them. (multi level; NOT for the total beginner).

TIM MAY

Tim's mandolin class will cover techniques and tunes. (multi level; NOT for the total beginner). "We'll look at the right- and left-hand problems that you may encounter in tunes, and how to deal with them: pick direction; tricks for gaining speed; and general technique."

ALAN O'BRYANT

Alan's class will cover tunes. (multi level; NOT for the total beginner).

UKULELE JOHN HATTON

Beginning Ukulele: 8 years old to adult; Where did the ukulele come from? a bit of history; How to hold and strum the ukulele; Learn Ukulele 'C' tuning; Make C, F, G chords and some songs

Intermediate Ukulele: Must be able to play & change chords quickly; Learn 2nd position chords, finger picking patterns, strums, syncopation, vamps and more; History of tunings based on the size of the instrument; class taught in 'C' tuning; Learn more songs.
